


Instructions to view Articulation Agreements on ASSIST.ORG



To be awarded for the art, all required courses for the major must be completed with a grade of C or better. NOTE: These courses are not required for admission to CU. Students must satisfy CU's requirements for the major in residence at CU. Agreement does not include all required courses for the major at CU. GENERAL EDUCATION - ENDURING QUESTIONS & IDEAS (Q&I)

The CUQ General Education (GE) requirement does not have to be completed prior to transfer. CUQ does, however, accept the following in place of all or part of the CUQ requirements: [skip](#) the GE Core and Theology courses requirements.

- SOTC (Statewide General Education Transfer Curriculum)
- CU (California State University General Education-Breadth Requirements)
- AOT (Associate Degree for Transfer)
- AA/AS (Associate of Arts/Science degrees which meet the CSU General Education-Breadth Requirements)

Students who plan to enter CU without completing an AOT, CU, AOT, or AA/AS with CU, they may take the courses below as credit to satisfy courses for major alignment towards GE requirements. To be considered for transfer, courses must be completed with a grade of C or better. View a complete list of GE requirements here: [View Transfer Policy Requirements](#). NOTE: Students with 29 or fewer transfer units prior to the first term of attendance, must take the following GE (Q&I) requirements at CU:
Biology, English Literature, History and Math.

***Students must take at least 1 Social Science course (ANT, ECO, PSC, SOC, COMM14 or COMM14) in answering the question, "How Shall I Live?" or the question, "Who Am I and Who Are They?"**

Students are strongly encouraged to review major requirements prior to selecting GE courses to identify courses that may apply to both GE and major prerequisites/requirements.
