ACADEMIC PROJECTS & COURSEWORK

- Group presentations = Communication, Teamwork
- Research papers = Critical Thinking, Time Management
- Class leadership roles = Leadership, Collaboration

Resume Example:

Team Lead, Group Research Project

- Led a team of 4 to research and present on environmental policy; delegated tasks, created visual aids, and presented findings to class of 30.

CLUBS & CAMPUS INVOLVEMENT

- Event planning = Organization, Project Management
- Leading a Bible study = Leadership, Public Speaking
- Club membership = Teamwork, Responsibility

Resume Example:

Member, Hispanic Student Association

- Collaborated with peers to organize cultural events and promote inclusion across campus.

FAMILY & LIFE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Caring for siblings or elders = Responsibility, Problem-Solving
- Budgeting or grocery shopping = Financial Awareness, Decision-Making

Resume Example:

Family Support Role

- Managed weekly schedules, meals, and transportation for two younger siblings while maintaining full-time coursework.

- Church volunteering = Service Orientation, Teamwork

- Mentored 6 middle school students weekly; planned and facilitated educational activities.
